The Sound of Music Festival has 5 stages and several entertainment Performance Pods. If you are scheduled to work at stages there are some rules that we ask all volunteers to follow when backstage.

- **PLEASE WEAR CLOSED TOED SHOES.**
- **Be prepared to do some heavy lifting and work.**
- **DO NOT approach any of the Talent back stage. If you wish an autograph you may request it of the stage manager.**
- **Always consult the Stage Manager if you have any questions and/or concerns.**
- **Report any incidents to the area Security manager (In the Gold shirts) and/or Stage Manager.**
- **Please remember that the Stage Managers are there all weekend long, long before and after every shift and they cannot do all the work themselves. You have volunteered in this position to work and not just to enjoy the show.**

Annually, our generous sponsors supporting the Festival receive naming right to our Stages and we will often refer to the stages by the sponsors' name. The stages are located throughout the park and the entertainment performance pods are located along Brant Street.

Your volunteer position will entail the following:

You will be helping the performers load and unload their equipment from the stage. Please follow the directions given to you as some of this equipment is very sensitive and not to be touched by anyone but the band themselves. Do remember that all equipment is very expensive and should be handled with care. In between loading and unloading times you may be asked to do a variety of tasks to help out. Please check with the area managers to determine what your next steps should be.
